The offending dog approached the victim, barking, and attempted to bite the victim's left hip, but the victim pushed the dog away. A minute later the dog returned and bit the victim on the left hip causing a small scratch. It is unknown if the victim sought medical treatment. The victim then reported the incident to the police on 6/26/15.

- B. Review Case #15-17952

1100 block of Oakton, sidewalk, 8/8/15 Saturday 1944 hrs.

The victim was walking a small dog and her granddaughter when two large Rottweiler dogs charged out from the backyard of a residence. She held the small dog she was walking and attempted to shield her granddaughter from the dogs, and as she attempted to move away from the dogs, one of them bit her finger. She was able to get inside the backdoor of 1035 Oakton and secure the door, and the dogs attempted to come in the home after her. PRFD was called to the scene and treated and released the victim at the scene. It is unclear which dog bit the victim.
