



Pet Owner Responsibilities and Regulations



Licensing: All dogs and cats must be licensed annually with the City for a fee of \$10.00 per year. The animal's Cook County Rabies Inoculation Certification Number must be provided to receive a City license. Applications are available from the cashier at City Hall.

Dog Waste and Leashes: To walk a dog in Park Ridge, the dog must be **ON A LEASH AT ALL TIMES** in **ALL AREAS**, except designated dog park or private property. Dog owners must have an implement or means for removing dog excrement and must be carried at all times. It is unlawful to leave your dog's excrement on any public or private property. Remember that animal excrement must not be allowed to accumulate even on your own property. Excrement must be disposed of properly.

Impoundment of Strays: Any dog found running at large (off the premises of the owner and not under control by a leash) within the City of Park Ridge shall be impounded.

Noise: It is unlawful to allow a dog to disturb the peace by excessive barking, howling, or whining.
