

## **City Manager's Report Week of May 23, 2011**

Thank you to everyone who has reached out to our State representatives in the House and Senate to express the importance of the Local Government Distributive Fund. As of today, both have informed us that there will be no change in the funding level. It will be the same as last year.

Attached is the formal resignation of services letter from attorney Steve Taber. The City Attorney has spoken to him and we will have the environmental attorney, Dennis Walsh from Klein Thorpe & Jenkins review the letter and create a correspondence authored by him, for use by the City. Once completed, we will share with the O'Hare Commission for their review and recommendation to the City Council.

Chief Kaminski and I met with Ken Wallace, Superintendent of School District 207 on the street crossing issue Wednesday morning. As you know, we have made recent sign improvements and have scheduled the crossing to have thermoplastic reflective markings this summer rather than just painting. Superintendent Wallace said he would initiate a discussion on this topic with his Board.

We have received a letter from the prospective developers of the O'Reilly Pub that they are no longer pursuing a site in Park Ridge.

This Saturday is the start of the Farmer's Market and Monday is the Memorial Day parade!
