

# City Manager's Report

## Week of November 14, 2011

We will seek your approval Monday to cancel the December 26<sup>th</sup> Council meeting and put all committees on the December 12<sup>th</sup> COW meeting. We want your feedback on whether to have the first meeting in January since there will be no COW meeting prior to that date.

Congresswoman Schakowsky's and Senator Durbin's representatives will be meeting with Barry Cooper of the FAA to push our request for a Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement for O'Hare Modernization Plan on November 22<sup>nd</sup>.

We are working with Advocate General Hospital System to see if a more "managed care" approach of the health care delivery to our employees and their families would be beneficial. They are going to review the claims history of the City to see if there are strategies that would both contain costs as well as providing the best and most timely delivery of appropriate medical services.

This morning, the City Attorney was informed by the attorney for PRC (uptown TIF retail owner) that the Uptown Homeowner's Association no longer wishes to purchase the parking space for its Homeowner's Association meeting room. Therefore, the City will retain ownership and there will be no closing on that space. Apparently, PRC had transferred the purchase and build money to the Homeowner's Association and once they knew they had the money in hand, they decided they would rather keep the money than have a meeting room. Since the sale was conditioned on our receipt of a purchase amount and those dollars will not now be forthcoming, no rescission action of the City Council will be necessary.

Today I received a request from the Cemetery Board to postpone the second reading for Landmark Designation at 2101 West Touhy Ave.

Attached is the personnel status update memo that I will review Monday under the City Manager's report.

I placed in your packet some additional information on electrical aggregation. More detail will be forthcoming.
