FRIDAY, DECEMBER 30, 2016 AT 10:00 A.M.

Acting Mayor Maloney called the hearing to order at 10:00 a.m. for Case 2017-MOEB-01. He reviewed the make-up of the Board which included City Clerk Henneman, Ald. Roger Shubert, and himself and steps taken to determine its composition. He explained the reason for the hearing which was due to an objection that was filed by Ald. Marc Mazzuca for the validity of some signatures placed on the petitions submitted by Sixth Ward Candidate De Stefano.

A ruling will be made at the next hearing based on results of the records examination of the signatures and for the notarization date on the Statement of Candidacy.
