A. Review Case #14-00836

1300 block of North Western Ave, residence, 1/11/14 Saturday 2015-2038 hrs.

The victim was sitting on the couch petting the dog, which belongs to the daughter. After the victim stopped petting the dog, the dog attacked the victim. According to the victim, similar unprovoked incidents have occurred over the past year, but are undocumented. The victim did receive medical treatment at the time of the incident by the PRFD for injuries to the left and right forearm.

B. Review Case #14-01031

1000 Peale Ave, sidewalk, 1/14/14 Tuesday 1549 hrs.

The victim was walking their dog (on leash) and saw two bulldogs run out of a residence on the 1000 block of Peale and attack the subject's Collie that was also being walked on leash. The victim ran to the aid of the subject in hopes of avoiding an attack to either the animal or the subject. When in close proximity of the subject and animals, the victim stated that the bulldogs turned and attacked the victim's Doberman as well as the victim's left arm. The victim did receive medical treatment at the time of the incident by the PRFD for injuries to the left forearm. The victim's Doberman was also bit in the rear right leg and received scratches as a result of the attack. The subject walking the Collie was chased by one of the bulldogs for approximately one block, but was able to fend off an attack and get away. The subject walking the Collie did not receive any injuries, but advised that their Collie was bit, but did not receive any puncture marks.
