1600 block of Walnut, Front Yard. 10/17/12 Wednesday 0830-0900 hrs.
The victim was walking westbound on the sidewalk on the north side of Walnut. The offender was walking eastbound on the sidewalk, also on the north side of Walnut. As the parties approached each other, the victim began to walk on the grass on the north side to avoid the dog. As the victim passed, the dog bit the victim on the left rear thigh area. The victim received medical treatment for injuries to the leg.
 - B. Review Case #12-24166
600 block of Elmore, Sidewalk/Parkway. 10/26/12 Friday 1955-2000 hrs.
The victim and witness were walking home eastbound on Cuttriss Street as a dog ran towards them, barking, growling and snarling, from the backyard of a house at Elmore and Cuttriss. The witness became afraid and began to give chase. The victim stood between the witness and the dog with their body facing away from the dog. The dog scratched the back of the victim's leg and then ran away toward Field School. The victim refused medical treatment at the time of the report.
 - C. Review Case #24538
1700 block of South Crescent, Sidewalk. 10/31/12 Wednesday 1800 hrs.
The victim and witness were walking on the sidewalk. A dog walked down the driveway from the gated property barking at the victim and witness. The victim and witness kept walking and the dog caught up to them and bit the victim on the left forearm. The victim refused medical treatment at the time of the report.
