1100 block of South Delphia Avenue, Driveway. 5/4/13 Saturday 1820 hrs.

The victim and mother were walking to the victim's vehicle when the neighbor's dog approached. The dog bit the victim on the right hand. The victim kicked the dog to attempt to get the dog to release, at which point, the dog owner's child came and got the dog. The victim suffered a bite mark to the right thumb (no break of the skin). Unknown if medical treatment was sought at the time of the incident.

- C. Review Case #13-10451

900 block of Florence Drive, Sidewalk, 5/23/13 Tuesday 1545 hrs.

The victim and dog were walking on the sidewalk when another dog appeared suddenly and attacked the victim's dog. The victim tried to separate the two dogs with the leash handle. The dog owner's family member then came outside and assisted in separating the dogs. The victim's dog sustained bites to the back, right rear leg and stomach. The victim was also bit on the left thumb and suffered scratches to the feet, but was not sure which dog caused the bite/scratches. The victim's dog received medical treatment at the time of the incident and the victim stated that they would visit the doctor the next day.

D. Review Case #13-11067

100 block of East Kathleen Drive, Sidewalk. 5/27/13 Monday 1630 hrs.

The victim was walking on the sidewalk and saw a female with a small dog on a leash. The dog began barking as the victim approached and the lady pulled the dog in as the victim continued to walk past. The dog bit/scratched the victim's right leg. The victim's clothing did not tear and it was not until later in the day that the victim realized that the bite/scratch broke the skin on the victim's leg. At the time of the initial report, the owner of the dog was unknown. As a result of calls for service in the days following the incident, related to this case, the dog owner was confirmed. It is unknown if the victim received medical attention at the time of the incident.
