1. "Quiet Communities Act Would Require EPA to Address Pollution from Aircraft Noise," *The Forum*, September 5, 2018. New legislation proposed in the Senate by Senators Kristin Gillibrand and Charles Schumer would require the EPA to reestablish the Office of Noise Abatement and Control to reevaluate the tools that FDA uses to measure and treat noise mitigation as well as the effectiveness of existing laws such as Noise Control Act of 1972, and for EPA to conduct airport noise studies.
