**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARK RIDGE
AMENDING ARTICLE 12, CHAPTER 6, SECTIONS 24 AND 12 OF THE
MUNICIPAL CODE OF PARK RIDGE**

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Park Ridge, Cook County, Illinois, pursuant to its home rule authority provided under Article VII of the Illinois Constitution of 1970 as follows:

SECTION 1: That Article 12, “Businesses and Occupations,” Chapter 6, “Alcoholic Liquors,” Section 24, entitled “Conduct of Employees and Agents,” of the Park Ridge Municipal Code is hereby amended which shall read as follows:

E. Before any ~~Class A, B, B-1, C or D liquor~~ license shall be issued, the prospective licensee shall provide evidence to the Commissioner that all employees who will be engaged in mixing, servicing, preparing or delivering alcoholic liquor to customers, guests, or patrons, have successfully completed a Beverage Alcohol Sellers and Services Education and Training (“BASSET”) Program conducted by an agency licensed by the Illinois Department of Alcohol and Substance Abuse. Each new such employee hired by the licensee after issuance of the license shall complete a BASSET program at the next available training session or within sixty (60) days of actually beginning work, whichever comes first. A copy of the certificate of completion of such BASSET program for each such employee shall be filed with the Commissioner. Each certification shall be renewed every three (3) years from the date of issue.

SECTION 2: That Article 12, “Businesses and Occupations,” Chapter 6, “Alcoholic Liquors,” Section 12, entitled “Temporary License,” of the Park Ridge Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding a new paragraph I which shall read as follows:

I. Each person who prepares, sells, delivers or serves any alcoholic liquor pursuant to a Class T license is required to sign a letter of understanding, on a form approved by the Commissioner, that states that the person has been advised of the rules and regulations regarding the preparation, sale, delivery and service of alcoholic liquors by the Class T liquor license holder. All persons who prepare, sell, deliver or serve any alcoholic liquor pursuant to a Class T license

are not required to complete BASSET training as required by Section 12-6-24.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval and publication in accordance with State law.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the City Clerk is authorized and directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form in accordance with State law.
