Background:

At the June 12, 2017 Committee meeting, Gewalt Hamilton Associates presented a parking study of the Uptown area. Over a period of several months, GW representatives obtained background information, documented existing conditions, considered future development, reviewed feedback from key stakeholders (through a staff led public outreach effort), and developed operational strategies and recommendations. At that time staff was directed to bring back the recommended changes for implementation.

Staff has prepared draft ordinances based on the Parking Study's recommendations for the following areas:

- Uptown Court Parking Lot – change 3-hour Free spaces to 90-minute Free, 92 spaces (13-15-6 to 13-15-4)
- Meacham – change from 2-hour Free spaces to 3-hour Free, street parking (13-12-6.1 to 13-5-6)
- Morris – change from 2-hour Free spaces to 3-hour Free, street parking (13-12-6.1 to 13-15-6)
- Summit Lot North – 3-hour Free spaces to 90-minute Free, 24 spaces (13-15-6 to 13-15-4)
- Summit Lot South – 5-hour Meter spaces to 3-hour Free spaces, 24 spaces. Many of these 3-hour Free spaces are currently being used by employees who have been issued parking passes thru the Police Department. (13-16-8 to 13-15-6)
- Prospect – add 2, 15-minute Free spaces by 23 South Prospect, (Two spaces north of center crosswalk adjacent to handicap parking area) (13-15-1)

Attached are the associated pages from the Parking Study, a GIS map of the area with changes noted, and Ordinance revisions.

It has come to Staff's attention that the No Parking area on Meacham at Northwest Highway has not been codified (13-11-1). As a matter of housekeeping, staff has included an Ordinance for this area for Council approval.

At the Committee meeting, Alderman Moran moved to amend the draft Ordinance revision to 13-15-1 to include two (2) 15-minute spaces on Main Street, at Fairview. The Ordinance has been revised to reflect this approved amendment.

This item was presented as an Action Item at the Committee of the Whole on July 17, 2017, at which time the Committee approved the motion on a roll call vote of 6/1 as amended, with Alderman Melidosian being the nay vote.

Recommendation:

Final approval of Ordinances amending various sections of Article 13, Chapters 12, 15 and 16 of the Municipal Code:

1. Approve revisions to 13-15-6 and 13-15-4, Uptown Parking Court, 3 hour to 90 minute zone
2. Approve revisions to 13-12-6.1 and 13-15-6, Meacham and Morris, 2 hour to 3 hour zone
3. Approve revisions to 13-15-6 and 13-15-4, Summit Lot North, 3 hour to 90 minute zone
4. Approve revisions to 13-16-8 and 13-15-6, Summit Lot South, 5 hour meters to 3 hour zone
5. Approve revisions to 13-15-1, South Prospect, 15 minute zone
6. Approve revision to 13-15-1, Main Street, 15 minute zone
7. Approve revisions to 13-11-1, Meacham No Parking areas

- 5) Repurpose 24, 5-Hour Meter spaces with 3-Hour Free spaces.






Exhibit 1 Legend
