

Advocate Aurora Health Accepting Donations for Supplies

As COVID-19 continues to impact our communities, we are committed to keeping our heroes - our doctors, nurses and team members - safe. As you know, the broader health care community is at risk of running low on critical personal protective equipment (PPE) across the country. Health care workers need these essential safety items on the frontline of this pandemic to effectively provide care. We are currently accepting the following items:

- **Masks** – Both N95 and procedural masks will be accepted. These masks can be found across many industries and have been deemed appropriate to use in the health care setting by the CDC. Commonly found in the construction and landscaping industry among others, we will gladly accept any new and unused masks.*
- **Hand sanitizer** – Personal sized hand sanitizer that has been unopened. CDC guidelines encourage sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol composition.
- **Eye protection** – This includes any new or unused goggles, safety glasses or face shields.
- **Disinfectant wipes** – All brands of unopened premoistened wipes are being accepted.
